## UPDATE ON THE CLEVEDON SHOWGROUNDS MULTISPORT FACILITY

The idea of a new multisport facility has received unanimous support from Clevedon sports clubs.

Clevedon's football, cricket and rugby clubs all use the Council-owned sports fields on Monument Road, but none of the clubs has clubrooms or a place to store gear. The Clevedon Bowling Club adjacent to the sports fields has clubrooms and a low membership, so a suggestion was made to extend the bowling club's premises to provide facilities for all four groups.

Project manager Hamish Frizzell says discussions with the local sports clubs have been very encouraging, and that the Franklin Local Board has also indicated support for the idea. While Clevedon Tennis Club has its own facilities, it also supports the idea and is keen to be involved in any future site developments that may better suit the club's requirements. Hamish says the bowling club is well positioned in relation to the other clubs' playing fields. "It seemed logical to work with the bowling club to better utilise their facility for the benefit of all four clubs."

The project committee has held preliminary discussions with Auckland Council regarding the land lease.

Changes to the existing bowling club would see the addition of a deck and storage area adjacent to the playing fields.

**LAND CARE AND THE CLIMATE.** Do your bit for both! Plant trees to sequester carbon to offset the emissions from your vehicle and enrich your environment. Carbon sequestration involves long-term storage of carbon dioxide and other forms of carbon to mitigate or defer global warming and is a way to slow the atmospheric and marine accumulation of greenhouse gases which are released by burning fossil fuels. 50% of the biomass of trees is made up of carbon removed from the atmosphere.

**THE WAIROA CATCHMENT NEEDS MORE TREES.** The Tasman Tempest and other deluges caused massive slips and flooding, leaving areas devoid of vegetation and prone to erosion. Task Force Green and local landowners have been doing a great job clearing slips, repairing fences, and replanting the devastated areas, but more needs to be done. Flax, cabbage trees, coprosma, putaputaweta, manuka, ribbonwood, kowhai, titoki, totara can be planted now. Tree ferns, nikau, karaka, puriri need to wait till you have a bit of shade and no frosts. For wetlands and flood prone areas the tough grasses *Carex secta*, *C. virgata*, *Cyperus ustulatus* are a good choice. Kahikatea's very strong root system and tolerance for wet ground make it ideal for flood prone areas.

### Award for Jessie Munro

A pioneering history of the Clevedon-Te Wairoa area south of Auckland has been awarded a national prize for its skilful use of archives and manuscripts. *Voices of Belonging: A History of Clevedon-Te Wairoa*, by Jessie Munro (published by Steele Roberts Aotearoa), received the Archives and Records Association of New Zealand's 2017 Ian Wards Prize at a ceremony in Wellington on 23 August.

The Ian Wards Prize recognises an outstanding piece of New Zealand historical writing, demonstrating innovative or exemplary use of archives and manuscripts. The judging panel said *Voices of Belonging* stood out for its innovative use of research resources, and is an outstanding example of scholarly good practice. '*Voices of Belonging* must be regarded as right at the forefront of the family and local histories genre. Taking the sometimes unique experiences of one small district, the author skilfully relates them to contemporary developments, both in Auckland Province and New Zealand as a whole.'

*Voices of Belonging* is an engaging, wonderfully written and informative read. It canvases most types of formats for research: oral histories, local manuscripts, government and council archives, family photographs, maps and a wide variety of secondary sources. The judging panel said Munro's publication offers a model for other writers to follow.

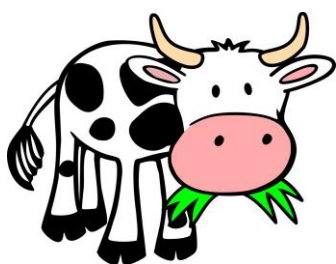

Hi all from your local Community Constable,

Property crime has been on the rise in our area again, so I want to remind everyone to keep on top of security, whether it be at home at work or out in public.

Walk out onto the road in front of your house and have a look at what you can see, does it look inviting to a potential burglar driving by?

Are there valuable items in plain view that would invite them in to take a better look at your house? If you have alarms and CCTV make sure they are in good working order.

When going about your daily business at work or home don't get complacent if you see a person or a vehicle that looks suspicious call 111, let Police decide if it's suspicious.

I have many instances when I'm out and about talking to people and they will tell me they saw a suspicious vehicle but didn't think to report it.

We do not want to give these offenders any opportunity to commit crime and once they think an area is an easy mark they will continue to target that area.

When you park your vehicle don't leave anything valuable in plain view, even a few coins left in the centre console can be a tempting opportunity.

If you are going into the shop lock and secure your vehicle, these offenders are always on the lookout for an opportunity and what starts out as a petrol drive off or shoplifting can quickly escalate into a much more serious crime if they sniff an chance.

Remember call 111 for ANY suspicious behaviour and 0800 555 111 for anonymous reporting of non-urgent information that may help Police.
