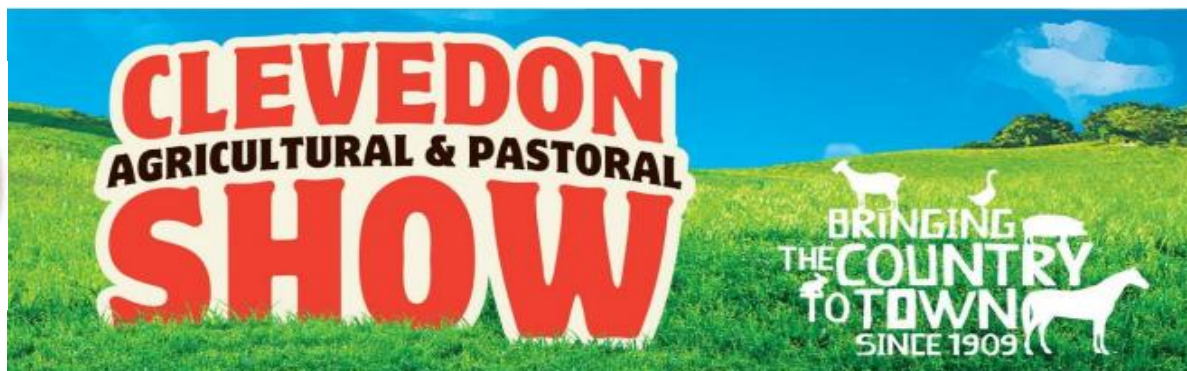

## CCBA & Fulton Hogan's Clevedon Quarry Expansion Proposal

Hearing dates for Fulton Hogan's proposed Clevedon Quarry Expansion Resource Consent Application have been set for 28 November – 7 December.

The CCBA will appear in support of our submission. We are also working closely with other groups in our community in an organised, collaborative and constructive manner that we hope will engender the support of the Hearing Commissioners, and influence a positive outcome for our community.

At this stage Fulton Hogan has indicated a willingness to talk. We note that after the Hearing there is no further opportunity for dialogue except through expensive Environment Court processes.

## Conversations with Fulton Hogan – November 2017

As you are all no doubt aware, Fulton Hogan has applied for Resource Consent to expand their quarry operations in McNicol Road from 100-200 to 1270 truck movements per day.

In our submission to this planning process Clevedon Conversations opposed Fulton Hogan's proposal and set out our specific areas of concern as they relate to the Clevedon Conversations master planning project. We have subsequently had conversations directly with Fulton Hogan regarding the concerns raised in our submission.

Clevedon Conversations exists to influence *Great Outcomes* during growth and development by employing a consultative and collaborative approach. Just as we are working with developers, landowners and Council to attempt to influence Great Outcomes for our village as its periphery is subdivided and its heart is intensified, we are also attempting to identify potential Great Outcomes for our community through the expansion of the quarry.

### Fulton Hogan Quarry

The Hearing on the Fulton Hogan Quarry expansion will be from Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> November to Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> December.

Clevedon Cares submission on this matter neither opposed nor supported the expansion application, preferring to take an approach which requests conditions be applied to various parts of the proposal, given that the quarry is a legitimate rural activity and obviously a quarry can only exist where there is suitable material to extract. We believe Fulton Hogan to be a responsible operator who recognise that the impact on the Clevedon environs is considerable, and we are endeavouring to achieve the best possible long term outcome for the Clevedon Valley and Village. We are in discussion with Clevedon Conversations, and the CCBA and Recreational Trails Group, who made similar submissions to ours, with a view to a joint approach at the Hearing. If you made a similar submission and would like to join these discussions please contact us.

## October/November 2017 Newsbrief

**A SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING is to be held at 7.30pm on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> November at the McNicol Homestead to decide on a change of name.** This is the first step in plans to revitalise our organisation and take on restoration work in the whole of the Wairoa River catchment – the entire area drained by the river, the streams and drains that flow into the river. The catchment extends from the source at Wairoa Reservoir dam near Paparimu all the way to the mouth at Pouto Point in Tamaki Strait. The deterioration of the river over the years has been due to land slips, logging, and various land use in all over the catchment, not just along the river banks, so work over the complete area is needed to achieve significant improvement. The plan is to establish a larger organisation with a wider membership of mainly people like you reading this, plus representatives of other community and special interest groups, Mana Whenua, businesses, and stakeholders. We already have the support of Local Board members and Council staff but to put our plans into action we need community involvement as well. It is Our River, Our Resource and Our Responsibility. Watch this space!

The propagating and supplying plants from our nursery, loaning our auger for drilling weed trees, supporting funding applications, planting on private land and similar operations will continue and is likely to extend, providing help and materials for weed and animal pest control.

**Other News. Managing Mud** is a NIWA research programme to determine the movement and fate of fine sediments in the Wairoa catchment, working with Ngai Tai and the Catchment Steering Group. **Predator Free Auckland.** Tony and Brendan attended a meeting with Brett Butland, Programme Director Pest Free Auckland with representatives from WildLink, Whakaupoko and Awhitu Landcare to discuss the establishment of and support for a predator free corridor from the Hunuas to the East Coast. **DOC Partnerships.** At a later meeting with senior DOC staff, hosted by Andrew Sinclair of Whakaupoko Landcare, we toured the extensive revegetated areas of Andrew's farm to demonstrate that private landowners are able to achieve good results on their own initiative. More would be achieved by volunteer community groups given support, expertise and help with materials by DOC and Council, particularly where umbrella groups are formed to cover a broad contiguous area for pest control.

**More benefits of Manuka.** Readers of the Sept 25<sup>th</sup> edition of the NZ FARMER may have read the report about new research that found "after heavy application of urea, the soil around Manuka trees contained dramatically less nitrate than around radiata pines used for comparison". 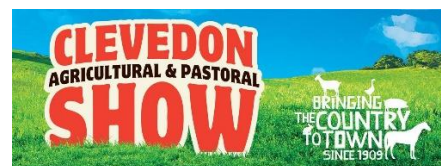

## **Labouring away**

Labour Day in New Zealand has a really interesting history. Way back in 1841 carpenter Samuel Parnell's refusal to work more than 40 hours sparked our country's first strike. Labour Day came to be celebrated in New Zealand on 28 October 1890, when thousands of trade union members and supporters attended parades in the main centres. It remained a major event for many years.

The ideal they spoke about then was that a person should work 8 hours, sleep 8 hours, and have 8 hours leisure – time spent with family, friends pursuing sports and other interests.

Figures indicate that for many New Zealanders now, working as they do some of the longest hours among developed nations, these ideals are a long way from reality. There is also an even more ancient view which affirms the importance of rest and freedom: The Sabbath Day. It is one of the 10 commandments that God gave to Moses.

This ancient law directed that every person (and even every working animal) should have a break every 7 days. The law was seen to uphold some important values and beliefs: it elevated humans above their work - affirming a calling beyond what we do - we are more than our jobs; and affirmed that we are not to remain slaves to our work – freedom is a quality central to understanding our humanity.

So as we plant our tomatoes, spend time with family or even find ourselves working, this Labour Weekend, it may be worth pausing to give thanks for those who have sacrificed much to affirm both the value of work but also the dignity of workers. Perhaps also to remember that our God given value is first of all found in who we are, and not, what we do.

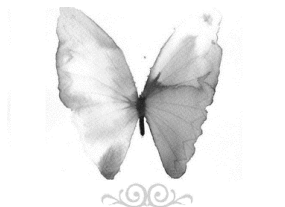

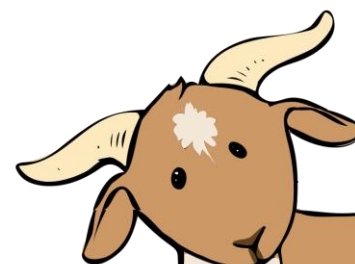
